The Stewart County Schools Family Resource Center provides an avenue in which parents can receive assistance in many areas related to school and family. The FRC provides the following services:

- Coordinates volunteers at each school
- Provides educational information
- Provides free educational materials
- Conducts workshops for parents
- Provides needed school supplies as well as other essential items such as clothing, shoes, and food items
- Creates and distributes custom-made file folders skill games
- Works with school counselors and nurses to match student/parent needs with available counseling, medical, and financial assistance
- Coordinates and assists with special school/family activities such as Open House, Grandparent's Day, Career Day, and Read across America Day, Parent-Teacher Conference, Red Ribbon Day, and Student/Parent Orientation.
- Coordinates special tutoring services for unique needs
- Serves as a referral agency for parents
